1. Call to order at 7:03 pm - Pledge of Allegiance

3. Treasurer's Report- (Lisa Pratcher) –Judy Pincus
 - a. Financial Report/Cash Position – Form 990 was filed with the IRS for last year. Approximately \$830 has come in from games. Law Nation raised \$6610 and has paid out \$3246 for student attendance. There are no more games until winter sports season. Law Nation averages over 100 kids attending per football game. Great turnout.
4. President's Report- (Judy Pincus)
 - a. Brick walk is complete and looks great. Judy will coordinate with Fran to create a big spring event for a ribbon cutting.
 - b. School Store: Judy will work with Michelle and get a teacher to sponsor Law's first DECCA club. Reached out to Foran for info and learning.
